March 27, 1972 - December 11, 2018

Brenda Jean Britton, 46, loving wife, mother, friend and beloved kindergarten teacher passed away on Tuesday, December 11, 2018 at home surrounded by loved ones. A celebration of her life is being planned and will be announced later.
