DonnaMae Baadsgaard passed away on Tuesday, December 29, 2020 at the age of 92 years. She was a good neighbor and friend. She had a keen mind and a passion for genealogy and was able to solve numerous family history connections. She spent over 50 years at the family history library where her assistance was given liberally. She had a strong testimony of Jesus Christ. Serving in her church was an important part of her life. She served in leadership positions and in every auxiliary of the church and supported her husband as he served in the church as well. Together they served a mission in England. A funeral service will be held for invited guests on Friday, 15 January 2020 at 10:00 am. Interment will follow at Tahoma National Cemetery.
