Adele Richards Salisbury passed away Tuesday, August 2, 2016, after a valiant fifteen-year battle with Parkinson's disease. A nine-year resident of Eltopia, WA, and formerly of Othello; Adele was 82.

She was born on October 30, 1933, in Mendon, Utah, to Mahonri and Arva Richards. After graduating from high school, Adele moved to Logan, Utah, and attended Utah State University. She was also a special student of the institute program at Utah State University.
