All this hands-on learning gave her what she needed to raise her own large family.

Adria married Roland Eugene DeLay in 1954, in Sunnyside, WA. Shortly after that the whole DeLay family moved to the Royal Slope where they farmed on Grandpa Ted's property, just above MarDon Resort. Seven kids made her a stay-at-home kind of mom but as they got older and could go with her, she would work her summers in the fields. As they began to graduate and find

their own way, she went to work as a cook in several local restaurants. Adria, though small in stature, was a feisty little fireball, loved by all who knew her.
