They then began their life together and worked as migrant farm workers, and later established their home in Moses Lake, Washington where she worked as a caregiver for many years.

Alice came to know the lord as her savior at the age of 30 at the Sendero De La Cruz church, and later was an active church member at the Assembly of

God church where she was involved in the choir, nursery, drama presentations, and prayer team. Alice was a strong Christian woman and a woman of faith. She believed in the power of prayer and was always praying for others no matter how big or small the need.

During her down time, Alice enjoyed spending time with her husband. She enjoyed going to Walmart to shop and to meet new people, and going out to eat. She also liked watching the Laker's and the Mariner's games, but most of all she enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren: Ricardo, Rosa, and Carlos.
