Alice Rendon, aged 69 passed away Monday, June 30th, 2025, ending a struggle with scoliosis and cancer. Alice was born on November 15, 1956 in Littlefield, Texas to Eusebio and Eva Campos and raised in Moses Lake, Washington.

Alice was a caring and loving wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, and friend to all who knew her. Alice lived a life full of love, laughter, and resilience. She dedicated her life to her family.

Alice is survived by her sons Brandon and Jarred (wife Mursal). Alice leaves a legacy behind in her grandchildren Elizabeth, Zane, Sloan, and Roshany.

Alice is also survived by her sisters Idalia, Rosie, Maria (husband Mike), and

brother Daniel Campos. Alice also had numerous nieces and nephews whom she loved including Chris Campos, Cassandra Botello (husband Israel), Cecilio Lopez, Sergio and Andy DeLeon, Oscar and Eva Campos, Heather Long (husband Chad), Enrique Guzman (wife Jessica), Guillermo & Lissa Rodriguez.
