



## Annabel "Ann" D. Keene

September 8, 1923 - June 7, 2012

Annabel "Ann" Deobald Keene, 88, of Moses Lake Washington, passed away peacefully on June 7, 2012. Ann was born in Kendrick, Idaho on September 8, 1923 to Edwin Albert and Anna Becker Deobald. She grew up with four siblings and graduated from Kendrick High School in 1941. Ann attended the University of Idaho before marrying her hometown sweetheart Lewis B. "Tom" Keene on September 12, 1942.

Tom and Ann lived in various locations as owner/operators of small businesses in Kendrick, Idaho, Joseph, Oregon, Prescott, Washington, Hooper, Washington and Kahlotus, Washington.
