Betty Lou's first teaching job was in Seattle. She also taught in Spokane, Moses Lake and two years in the dependant's school in Munich, Germany. In 1953, she married Kenneth A. Goodrich in Spokane. They made their home on Ken's farm unit in Block 42 and Betty Lou became a full time homemaker. Their son, Ken, was born in 1955 and their daughter, Mary Lou, was born in 1958.

Betty Lou was an active member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Her hobbies were heirloom sewing and collecting antiques. Her

favorite activity was to attend an antique show with her friends and finding just the right thing to add to her collections.
