Bobby Glyn Chandler passed away on December 23, 2010 in Wenatchee, Washington. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, December 30, 2010 at the Christian Missionary Alliance Church in Moses Lake, Washington. Burial will follow at Guarding Angels Cemetery. Public viewing will take place at Kayser's Chapel on Wednesday, December 29, 2010 from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Bobby was a loving husband, father, grandfather, son, brother and friend who loved life, family and fun. His most proud accomplishments were that of his children and grandchildren. Bobby is remembered by many as a fun-loving practical joker who loved to make others laugh.

Bobby was born to Glyn and Frances Chandler on January 4th 1948 in Wenatchee, Washington. The oldest of 5 children Bobby would go on to graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Chemistry from Central Washington University and on to Multnomah School of the Bible where he completed a certificate of Biblical Studies. daughter Bobbie Joy Chandler. Bobby loved his family very much and received great joy from his grandchildren, Sidney Elizabeth Chandler and Cormac Sean Chandler both born to his oldest son Sean.

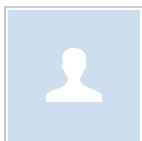

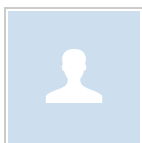
