



## Carl Leonhart

March 29, 1926 - May 19, 2016

Carl passed away Thursday, May 19 at Lakeshore West Residential Care in Moses Lake, WA at the age of 90. He was born March 29, 1926 to Francis and Nellie Leonhart in Minneapolis, KS. Carl was the last surviving sibling of thirteen children. At the age of 17, Carl joined the Navy during WWII and served as a carpenter's mate in the SeaBee's Division.

On March 5, 1948, Carl married the love of his life, Evelyn Anderson (a war-widow) and her toddler daughter, Diana. Another daughter, Linda, was born the following year. The couple resided in Woodburn, Or for the next 50 years before moving to Moses Lake, WA in 1999 to be near their daughters and their families.

Carl was a talented finish carpenter until his retirement in 1988. He was an avid fisherman and loved all sports and games. His great sense of humor and teasing brightened everyone's day.

Carl's wife, Evelyn, preceded him in death on August 5, 2014.
