June 28, 1916 - May 29, 2010

Caroline Schmauder, 93, longtime Moses Lake resident passed away Saturday, May 29, 2010 at the Monroe House. Viewing will be held from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Wednesday, June 2nd at Kayser's Chapel. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. on Thursday, June 3rd at Immanuel Lutheran Church with Pastor David Daus officiating. Interment will follow at Pioneer Memorial Gardens. Caroline was born on June 28, 1916, in Jordan, Montana, daughter of the late Johan and Katherina Bitz. At the age of three her parents moved to Eureka, South Dakota. She was raised on the farm and worked in the Eureka Nursing Home. She came to Dryden, Washington with her father and two brothers who worked in the apple harvest. She met Edward Schmauder and they were married on January 13, 1938 in Odessa, Washington. They farmed on the family farm. They had two children, Joyce Ann Schmauder and Donald Edward Schmauder. In 1970 they retired and moved to Moses Lake. In 2001 Caroline moved to the Monroe House Assisted Living Retirement Community. She was an active member of Immanuel Lutheran Church. Caroline enjoyed gardening, crafts, sewing quilts for Lutheran World Relief and spending time with family.

Caroline is survived by her son Donald Schmauder; three sisters, Martha Schrenk, Seattle, WA, Lydia Brink, Minneapolis, MN, and Fredia Heiser, Bismark, ND. Besides her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Edward, daughter, Joyce, four brothers and four sisters.
