Clifford graduated from high school in 1954. Later that same year he eloped with Sandra Diane Hardman, and they remained married for nearly 71 years, until his passing. Cliff and Sandy raised four sons, Rick, Eddie, Gary and Michael. Eddie was lost to leukemia in 1969 at the age of ten.

He beat both conditions and stuck around for 25 years to help with great grandkids, who, thanks to him and his wife Sandra, never spent a minute in daycare.
