



## Clinton E Anderson

November 10, 1945 - April 18, 2023

Clinton Emil Anderson, a long time Royal Slope resident, passed away on April 18, 2023 at the age of 77. Born in Spokane on November 10, 1945, he was the only child of Columbia Basin pioneers Clinton Eugene Anderson and Ethel Elizabeth Reynolds. In 1958 Clint's dad brought Clint and his mother back to the family farm on Royal Slope where he finished high school. Clint was proud to be a member of the Othello High class of 1964. After graduation he began his 47 year career as a surveyor for the Bureau of Reclamation. The greatest joy in his life came in February of 2010 when his only grandchild, Benjamin Joseph Anderson, was born.

Although Clint was an only child, he had close relationships with many extended family members, especially his in-laws and cousins. He is preceded in death by his parents, cousins' Dick German, Karen Spellman and a sister-in-law Lavina Landauer. He is survived by his daughter Corrine and grandson Ben, five cousins, Sally Gentch, Susan McAdams, Sandra Lara, Nadine Palmer, Sharon Gillahan, and two brother's-in-law, Robert and Richard Landauer.
