



Clyde Eric Tervo

July 5, 1943 - January 12, 2024

Unexpectedly, Clyde Eric Tervo, 80, from Moses Lake, WA, passed away at his residence on January 12, 2024. His sudden departure has left his family deeply saddened.

Clyde entered the world on July 5th, 1943, born to Eric and Evelyn Tervo in Superior, Wisconsin, and subsequently grew up in Moses Lake, Washington. Among his siblings were James Tervo and the late Lorraine Burgess. a Letter of Commendation from the Armored Commanding Captain, citing his commendable attitude and unwavering devotion to duty, recognizing them as valuable assets to his unit.
