Connie Kay Campbell, 68 went home to be with her Lord and Savior after a courageous 1 year long battle with Leukemia and Breast Cancer, on Saturday June 25, 2011 with her loving family at her side. Connie was born at her grandmother's home in Sheridan, Missouri on a "very" cold day on January 20, 1943 to Ernest (Tine) Hawbeck and Bertha Mae Wilson Hawbeck.

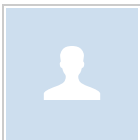

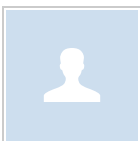
