Daniel Edward Mansfield, 74, surrounded by family passed peacefully into the arms of Jesus on Sunday, September 19, 2021.

Daniel E Mansfield was born on November 7, 1946 in El Reno, Oklahoma to parents Louis and Mary Ann Mansfield. He grew up in Buena Vista, Colorado then his family moved to Alamosa, Colorado where he worked in the family gas station and graduated from Alamosa High School.

Daniel enlisted in the U.S. Army right after graduation and completed his basic training at Fort Bragg, North Carolina. He served our country during the Vietnam War from 25 February 1966 – 24 February 1972. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, and Vietnam Service Medal. After receiving an honorable discharge, Dan moved to Cle Elem, Washington to be with his parents.

Dan met the love of his life, Carol, in September of 1975. After a short courtship, they were married on November 28, 1975, becoming an instant family with Carol's daughter, Kim. After a couple of years, they added a son, Steven and a daughter, Kristin.
