Darlene Susan Hannon, 57, gained her wings on January 12, 2024, with her family by her side at Columbia Basin Hospital in Ephrata, WA. Darlene was born to Larry and Lou Rhea Crapson on March 11, 1966 in Seattle, WA. At the age of 5, Darlene and her family moved to Moses Lake, WA where she grew up attending kindergarten through high school. In 1986, Darlene married Frank Hannon and gave birth to their son, Kyle Hannon in January of 1987. She was an employee of Confluence Health for several years as a receptionist. Darlene loved anything to do with the outdoors. She enjoyed riding her motorcycle and the thrill of off-roading. Everyone loved being around her and she loved her friends as much as they loved being around her. She always made sure that every child that crossed her threshold was safe, happy and healthy. She was known as “mom” to any child to who came around.

In May of 2009 she survived a tragic motorcycle accident leaving her as a quadriplegic. After her accident she resided in an Assisted Living facility until she passed. It would be wrong to say that Darlene lost her battle, because she never stopped fighting. No matter how hard the obstacle was for her, she was always determined. When anyone would have broken, Darlene stayed strong. Through her we know what resilience and perseverance truly looks like. There was no quit in Darlene. Just because she is no longer with us, doesn't mean she lost her fight.

She was preceded in death by her father Larry, her two brothers Loren and

Duane, and three sets of Grandparents. She is survived by her son Kyle (Kortney), grandchildren Kyla, Ruger, Devon, KashLyn and Gwen. Mother, Lou Rhea, brother Steven (Carol), niece Sophia, and several aunts, Uncles and cousins.
