David S. Forsberg, beloved husband, father, and grandfather passed away Friday, September 18, 2015 at Samaritan Hospital after a lengthy illness with family at his side. Since his father passed away when he was only 5, he learned to overcome many difficulties and work hard on the family farm. He was proud of his Swedish heritage as he could only speak Swedish before starting school and could still remember some Swedish words, even to the last. After many years of farm life in the Midwest, Dad and Mom moved to Florida in 1966 where he started a new life as a real estate broker/investor. After taking several road trips to Washington to visit two of his children, he decided to permanently retire in Moses Lake in 1976. He enjoyed spending winters in Florida until he could no longer drive that far.
