



## Delmar George Laib

Delmar George Laib was born February 22nd, 1934 in Warden, WA to Edward and Emma (Stoller) Laib. Delmar passed in the evening of Wednesday, May 3rd, 2023.

Delmar grew up on the family farm in Warden with his 7 sisters and 3 brothers. He attended Warden Schools until moving to Ritzville, WA in the Summer of 1948 where he eventually graduated from High School. Delmar was an excellent student and always achieved high grades.

At that time they moved to his brother, Alvin's wheat ranch at Warden, WA and when Alvin retired, Delmar and Marian took over the farm where he remained until Nov. of 2022. Delmar also enjoyed pheasant hunting in his younger years. He was a member of the Warden Community Church and served in many different capacities there throughout the years.

Delmar also enjoyed good food! People often wondered how he could eat the volume of food he did and not have a weight problem. He especially enjoyed Molly Kisler's cookies, and his

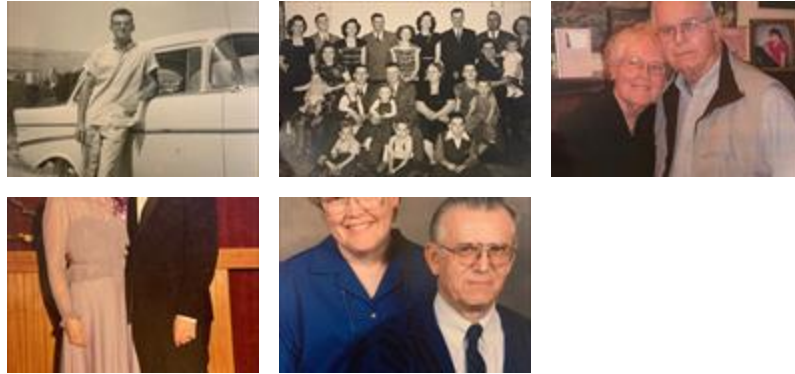
