



## Dennis M. Jordan

March 29, 1946 - January 9, 2014

Dennis M. Jordan, 67, a longtime resident of Coulee City died Thursday, January 9, 2014 after a yearlong battle with cancer. He was born March 29, 1946, in Wenatchee, WA to Emanuel and Eunice (Peterson) Jordan. He lived in the Withrow/Waterville area attended Elementary School in Withrow, WA and graduated from Waterville High School in 1964. He entered the Naval Reserve in the summer of 1963 and began active duty after graduation in June of 1964. Upon completing his Naval service in July of 1969 he returned home and worked for a short period of time for Alcoa in Wenatchee, WA before joining the now Central Washington Grain Growers. He retired from Central Washington Grain Growers where he served in many capacities ending as Outside Foreman in March of 2012.
