Dolores "Dee" Rita Shipley, 82, long time resident of Warden, passed away the morning of Thursday, October 25, 2012.

Dee was born to the late John and Mary Miller on May 22, 1930, in Colorado. Dee graduated from high school in Ouray Co and then attended and graduated Loretta Heights Catholic girls' school in Denver Co. She then married the late Theodore R. Shipley and moved to Bridgeport, Washington for a short time in the early 50's with their first two children. The two then began a homestead in Warden in 1952 where they were blessed with two more children. She spent her younger years as a homemaker while raising the kids. In 1967, she decided enter into the workforce and took a secretarial position with Cunningham Insurance which later became Irwin Insurance Agency. After giving over 20 years of service she retired in 1990.

She was a highly active member of the Queen of All Saints Catholic church where she was instrumental in initial construction of the church. She dedicated her life and spread her love for helping other in need. Her enjoyment of cooking and baking has touched the lives of many and was always greatly appreciated and will be missed.
