Dorothy Josephine (Snyder) Skolrud went to be with her Lord on Thursday, August 27, 2020, in Moses Lake, Washington. She was born on February 5, 1935, to Claude Paul and Beatrice Cecil (Stimpson) Snyder in Yakima, Washington. She was the youngest of six children.
