October 6, 1922 - June 30, 2013

Douglas H. Valline, 90, a Moses Lake resident passed away Sunday, June 30, 2013 at the Blue Goose Care Center in Moses Lake. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m., Monday, July 8th at the Rose Street L.D.S. Church. Interment with military honors will follow at the Hartline Cemetery in Hartline, Washington.

Douglas was born in Emmons, Minnesota on October 6, 1922, son of the late David and Ethel (Thomas) Valline. He served in the U.S. Army and received a purple heart for saving his sergeant. He returned to his wife, Fern and 2 year old daughter, Gloria, at the end of his tour. He worked for 33 years for the Washington State Department of Transportation, including North Bend and Quincy areas, before retiring. After retiring he worked at places including his own 76 gas station in Ephrata, Robertson & Thomas Motors, Inland Oil and Soap Lake School District.
