Earl Michael Kane (always “Mike”) was born on June 30, 1949, in Spokane, WA to Earl LeRoy and Elva Mae Kane. He passed away on the morning of February 17, 2025, in Moses Lake, WA.

Mike lived north of Wilson Creek, WA on the family dry land wheat farm all his life. He grew up driving tractors, combines, and trucks, and working on all of them when they broke down.

Mike married Rita Marie Foldoe on March 20, 1971, in Ephrata, WA. They have 4 sons, Mark Aaron, Bradley Dale, Devin Michael, and Dustin Scott.

After farming, Mike drove a semi hauling wheat and then fuel. Eventually he bought his own rig and hauled produce to and from Arizona, New Mexico and Texas, with a couple of trips to Florida. As a lifelong Washingtonian, he got a kick out of seeing alligators.

Mike loved taking his sons, nephews, nieces, and grandkids on short runs. He always showed great pride and love for his family.

Mike had a debilitating stroke in April 2007. He was able to be at home with his wife, Rita, until September 2024 when he suffered a severe head injury, after which he needed skilled nursing care.

Mike was preceded in death by his father, Earl, in 1995. He is survived by his mother, Elva, his wife, Rita, their four sons, Mark (Cori), Brad (JaNeil), Devin (Tonya), and Dustin. He has three sisters, Marla Jean Phillips, Marsha Mae Kane, and Marlene Denise Kane, also numerous niece's and nephews.
