Florence I. Lehmann, 88, Moses Lake resident and formerly of Lake Chelan passed away Monday, Dec. 13, 2010 at Moses Lake Senior Living Community. Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, Dec. 15, 2010 at Kayser's Chapel. Interment will be held at 11:30 a.m., Friday, Dec. 17, 2010 at the Omak Cemetery. Florence was born on May 5, 1922 in Havillah, Washington. She was raised and educated in Omak. Florence married Albert R. "Bert" Lehmann on Feb. 1, 1942 in Omak where they resided until moving to Wenatchee. They lived in Wenatchee for a short time before moving to Chelan in 1948. Albert and Florence purchased the Phillips 66 Station and the Snack Shack in Chelan where she did all the cooking. They bought the Richfield station in 1950 and later owned and operated the Trading Post. They sold their businesses, except for the Trading Post, which they operated until 1976. Florence then worked sorting apples in the packing sheds in Wenatchee until the early 1990's when she retired.

She liked gardening, crocheting and embroidering when living in Chelan. She and Bert were members of the Swinging Lakers Square Dance Club and celebrated their 50th Anniversary with a square dance. In the past few years she enjoyed word search puzzles and reading her bible.

She is survived by one daughter and son-in-law, Janet and Herb Ward, Othello; sister, Ruby Fields, Omak; two grandchildren, Kristin Rogers, Moses Lake and Robert Rogers, Othello; 6 great grandchildren; 2 great-great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, husband and one brother.
