Gerald "Jerry" McKee, 74, longtime Moses Lake resident, passed away Monday, April 14, 2008 at University Hospital in Seattle, WA.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. Monday, April 21, 2008 at Kayser's Chapel of Memories with Pastor Gene White officiating. Interment will follow in the Ephrata Cemetery. Arrangements are in care of Kayser's Chapel & Crematory. Viewing will take place at the funeral home on Friday evening from 5:00 until 7:00 p.m. and Saturday morning from 8:00 a.m. until noon.
