March 31, 1918 - September 28, 2015

Grace Elizabeth Morris, 97, former long time Moses Lake resident, passed away Monday, September 28, 2015 at Cottage in the Meadow, a hospice facility, in Yakima, Washington.

After Orville retired, they served as missionaries in the South Dakota, Rapid City Mission and then as ordinance workers in the Seattle Temple.
