Helen M. Pugh, 72, longtime Moses Lake resident, passed away Tuesday, October 26, 2010 at her home. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:00 a.m. Monday, November 1, 2010 at Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church in Moses Lake with Father Felipe Pulido as celebrant. Graveside services will follow at 3:00 p.m. at St. Joseph's Cemetery in Spokane. Viewing will take place at the funeral home on Saturday, October 30th from 8:00 a.m. until noon.

Helen Margaret Nachtwey was born on July 2, 1938 to Clifford and Marguerite Nachtwey in Spokane, Washington. She graduated from Mead High School in 1956. She married Harold Pugh on April 19, 1958 in Spokane. They lived in several different towns throughout the Northwest while Harold worked in Construction. They had four sons between October of 1959 and September of 1963. They purchased Correll's Scale Service in 1970 and then moved to Moses Lake in October of 1971. They had their only daughter in February of 1972. Harold and two of their sons died in a plane crash in 1985, leaving her a widow.
