On October 6, 2010 Scotty went to rest with the Lord after a short battle with cancer.

Scotty was born Henry Howard Scott on September 14, 1933 to Zara and Helen Scott in Delano, California. He grew up in California and graduated from Fresno State University with a teaching degree.

After getting married, Henry left active duty and went into the Army Reserve for 33 years, where he reached the rank of Command Sergeant Major.

He and his wife settled on their own farm in Bremerton, Washington to raise their daughter Kim. He was employed by the Bremerton School District in 1963 and he taught there until his retirement in 1993. Scotty then relocated his family to a farm in Warden, Washington where he was employed from 1994-2010 as substitute teacher and by Affordable Tax Service as a tax accountant for 1996-2010.

Scotty enjoyed life. He was very active in The Kitsap Sherriff Posse, in 4-H, The Northwest Junior Rodeo Association, and The Columbia Basin Barrel Racing Club. He also loved to bowl, garden, farm, and to fish and hunt with his boys. He never missed a wrestling tournament for his grandson, and the Warden wrestling family could always count on Henry to keep the bracket

sheet up to date for the entire team. Scotty was always on the go, but was never too busy to lend a helping hand. Scotty's family was always first in his life.

Scotty was preceded in death by both parents Zara and Helen Scott, his two brothers Jim and Stan Scott, his mother-in-law Regina Prouse, and his father-in-law Lloyd Prouse.

He is survived by his wife Marge Scott, daughter Kim Trupp, son-in-law Donald Trupp, and his grandsons Dakota Scott and Dahani Trupp. He is also survived by his bother Gary Scott, his in-laws Janet and Jim Tate, Joyce Pate, Ken Prouse, Dave and Dottie Prouse, and many nieces and nephews.
