Jolane D. "Jody" Arbuckle, 66, a 40 year resident of Moses Lake, WA, passed away October 19, 2008 after a very brave fight against cancer. 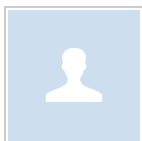
