It is with profound sadness that we announce the sudden passing of Larry Duane Matheson. Larry suffered a heart attack on Friday, October 21st, 2011. Larry was born in Moses Lake, Washington, on June 11th, 1958, the middle son of Christopher and Guynell Matheson. Larry spent all of his childhood and most of his adulthood in and around the Moses Lake area, growing up on the family farm north of town.
