He underwent open heart surgery at only 5 days old. In spite of his successful heart repair he had complications that were due to an unknown medical condition. During his life at Sacred Heart, he repeatedly surprised his PICU family by making it through countless obstacles. He was affectionally know to them as "Leo", their little lion. Even though he couldn't talk he communicated best with his very expressive eyes. During his short time there, Leandro enjoyed listening to music, oral care, snuggling with his parents and story time with daddy. After 4 1/2 months of being so strong and brave, he let us know he was tired. He passed away peacefully in his parents arms and surrounded by his grandparents at Sacred Heart on December 16, 2019. Leandro was deeply loved and fiercely protected by his parents. He touched many lives during his short time here and God's love truly shined through him everyday.
