LeiAnn K Treat passed away November 25, 2008 in Spokane, WA after losing a battle with cancer. She was born November 5, 1963 in San Diego, CA.

LeiAnn's family moved from San Diego to Federal Way, WA where LeiAnn and brother Jason attended elementary school. The next family move was to Vashon Island. LeiAnn attended high school on Vashon where she played softball and was active in 4-H. She was once the Junior Champion Showman at the King County Fair. LeiAnn graduated from Eastern Washington University in 1986 with a BA in Recreation Therapy.
