LeRoy went home to be with his Lord on Nov. 25, 2024. He was born on Jan. 19, 1931 to parents Lucille and Walter Weber on a farm north of Culbertson, NE. The family moved to a farm near McCook, NE where they lived through the flood of 1935.

LeRoy attended a country school near home in Trenton, NE. His father fixed his bike so he could carry his three sisters to school with him- Sherry on the handlebars, Jean on the seat platform behind, and Genevieve on the seat. LeRoy stood, pedaling back and forth to school.

The Weber family lived in the Culbertson and McCook area until they returned to McCook in 1944.

After LeRoy graduated high school in 1949, he went to work for a farmer. He married Juanita Carroll (d 1994) in 1950. They stayed in McCook until 1957. LeRoy went to work for the Bureau of Reclamation and in 1960 he transferred to the Royal Slope, WA area. LeRoy and Juanita had four boys- Ron, Keith, Robert, and Michael.

After a few years, the family moved to Royal City and LeRoy began farming. He farmed until 1985 and after auctioning off his farm equipment, he went to

work for the Napa Auto Parts store in Royal City. He married Henrietta (Hanky) J. Roosma Nov.24, 1995.

The two of them took many oversea trips to work on missions-Papa New Guinea, Togo, So. Africa, Portugal. In 1972 LeRoy obtained his private pilot license. In 2000 he and Hanky moved to Moses Lake, WA.

Henrietta died in 2018 and in 2019 LeRoy married Sandra(Sandee) Keith. They took trips to visit out of state family and also two missions trips- ABWE in Harrisburg, PA and Regeneration Reservation in St. Thomas, AZ

LeRoy is survived by wife Sandee, sons Ron (Jody), Robert, and Michael (LaDonna). Eleven grand children and their spouses; sixteen great grandchildren and five great-great grandchildren.

LeRoy is preceded in death by his parents and grandparents, his son Keith (Debbie) and his sisters Genevieve and Sherry.
