Linda found great peace and inspiration while watching the waves crashing on the Washington shore. She accomplished life goals there of journaling and writing poetry. Linda graduated from Ballard High School in Seattle, WA in 1959 and went on

to attend the University of Washington. Linda started her career at the University of Washington in the HR department. She worked for the Grant County Auditor's Office starting in 1981 and Big Bend Community College as the Payroll Manager. She moved on to have a 15 year career in administrative internet technology systems, as an HRMS Manager, for Washington higher education institutions.
