Lorraine Mae Zwonechek Linderholm was born May 19, 1925 in Wilbur, NE, to Joseph and Erma Zwonechek. In 1935 her parents and grandparents moved the family to Longview to find work during the Great Depression. Lorraine graduated from R.A. Long High School in 1944. She married Carleton F. Linderholm on June 15, 1946.

Lorraine started working for the State of Washington's Employment Security office in Longview in 1964 as a seasonal claims taker. In 1975 she became a permanent employee and later became a claims adjuster. She retired in 1986.

Lorraine loved history. She also enjoyed baking, gardening, and doing craft projects. Lorraine was also a member of the Royal Neighbors Lodge in Longview and served as oracle for two terms. She is a beloved mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. Her laughter, stories, and sense of humor will be greatly missed.

She is preceded in death by her parents, her husband Carleton, an older brother Robert Zwonechek, and two younger sisters Bertha Sincomb and Betty Parkison.
