Louise Colby ( Weetzi ) Piper, passed away at home in Moses Lake, Washington, December 8th, 2021. She was 101 years old.

Louise was born in San Diego, May 30, 1920, one of five children. She attended Sweetwater High School where she met Henry Piper. They were married June 22, 1941. Louise and Henry raised four boys in a two bedroom home in Chula Vista, California, before moving to Bonita.

After Henry passed away in 1993, Louise lived independently in her two story house, until just four days before she passed.
