After retirement she help at ML Floral and ML Athletic Club (where she enjoyed getting Dairy Queen sundays from Mr. Tom Whittle) until she was 92 years old.

Homemade cheeseburgers were a big delight as well as fried potatoes and chocolate cake. Yahtzee was a favorite game to play and she usually won.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Everett Bennett and sons Calvin and Clayton. Parents Oscar and Tina Wymore, brother in law Wally Jacks and many aunts and uncles.

She is survived by her sister, Dixie Jacks of Moses Lake; nieces, Debbie (Mike) Leedom, Terry (Don) Sell; nephew Pat (Liz) Jacks; and grandsons
