Mary Alice (Wolski) Morin died at the McKay Rehabilitation Center on March 28th at 9:04pm surrounded by family.

Mary was born in Wolf Point, MT, on May 23rd, 1943 to Edward and Eileen Wolski. She completed high school with a GED from Big Bend Community College in 1984 while living in Moses Lake, WA.

On July 1, 1960 she married Thomas Edward Stanfill at Wolf Point, MT. Their union resulted in the birth of a daughter, Cheryl-Lee Ellen Stanfill Berreth, and a son, Edward Arnold Stanfill, before divorcing in January of 1969.

On June 14, 1969 Mary married Donald Edward Morin at Medicine Lake, MT resulting in the birth of son Scott Alan Morin.

Mary worked for Kmart Corp. in Moses Lake, WA, Portland, OR, and Vancouver, WA for a total of 17 years. She also worked for SEH-America in Vancouver, WA before retiring in September of 2005.

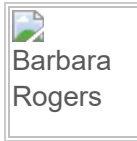
