September 4, 1943 - September 20, 2015

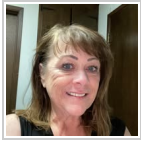
Mary Diane Roberts, 72, a resident of Moses Lake and formerly of Everett, Washington passed away Sunday, September 20, 2015 at home.

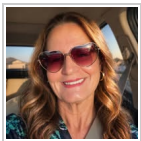

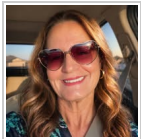


“ *Desiree Kallam lit a candle in memory of Mary Roberts*

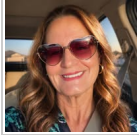
