Minnie S. Carvo, 83, longtime Moses Lake resident passed away Saturday, October 31, 2009 at Samaritan Hospital. While in Yakima, she met Gerald "Jerry" Carvo while he was on leave from the Navy, and they were late married on July 8, 1947 at St. Paul's Catholic Church in Yakima. They lived in Seattle for a short time before moving to Moses Lake in 1956 where they have lived since.

Minnie was a very active longtime member of Our Lady of Fatima Catholic Church. She was involved with the Women's Guild and prayer chain of the church. She was an avid supporter of the annual Carvo Classic Golf Tournament. Her greatest joy in life was her faith and her family. She loved children, sewing, baking and decorating cakes. Minnie wrote some wonderful

poetry and enjoyed watching the Mariners and Seahawks.

I pray that the Lord's blessing will attend you all during the upcoming Holiday season. I know Minnie will be close by.. loving you, and working for her family.

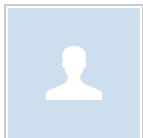
