Nicanor Gonzalez Valdez (Nick), 73, passed away peacefully, surrounded by his children and loving wife, on October 9, 2022. He was a longtime resident of Moses Lake and a retired Grant County Deputy Sheriff.

Nicanor is survived by his wife, Olga Cecilia Pardo Valdez and his six children: Rachel Valdez (Tamara), Becky Valdez, Anita De Leon (Alex), Nicanor Valdez Jr. (Tami), Veronica Garcia (Josue), and Marcos Valdez.
