NonaVee “Nonie” Payne, 85, longtime Warden resident passed away Monday, September 24, 2012 at Emeritus Hearthstone Inn. Payne, on December 3, 1945 in the Manti LDS Temple. They made their home in Sigurd Utah where they raised their children on the Payne family farm.

In December of 1966, Val and NonaVee moved their family to Warden where she has resided until her death.

NonaVee was the mother of 11 children, 3 Sons and 8 daughters. She worked hard as a homemaker all of her life. Some of Nonie's interests were gardening and canning her home-grown vegetables for her family. She loved crocheting and blessed her children and grandchildren with a large afghan for their wedding gifts. She had a great sense of humor and a quick wit. One of her philosophies of life was "It doesn't matter what the question is..... the answer

NonaVee was a faithful, active member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, and she willingly accepted callings until she became ill a year ago. Nonie was a great example to all who knew her. She was a kind, thoughtful, honest, faithful and caring person, who showed and gave love to anyone who came into her life.
