



Ottis Ivan Miller

February 5, 1915 - July 20, 2016

Ottis Ivan Miller, 101, a resident of Moses Lake and formerly of Steubenville, OH, passed away Wednesday, July 20, 2016 at his home. Interment will be at Fort Steuben Burial Estates in Wintersville, Ohio.

Ottis was born on February 5, 1915 to Otto William and Effa Blanche Miller in Derwent, Ohio. He worked as a beekeeper in Michigan and New York State before joining the Army in 1940. Ottis served in Europe during the D-Day invasion in Normandy and was wounded in action. He received a Purple Heart and a Silver Star and he attained the rank of Technical Sergeant before his Honorable Discharge on August 28, 1945. After his service in the Army, Ottis worked as a carpenter until his retirement after attaining a 55 Year Badge. Ottis was preceded in death by his parents and his wife, Eleanor Brisko Miller; brothers Clarence Miller, Howard Miller, and Hershel Miller; and his sister Eileen Jones.

Survivors include a niece, Shirley Merkle of Moses Lake.
