



## Pauline Cobean

July 24, 1916 - June 28, 2008

Pauline Cobean, 91, Moses Lake, WA., died Saturday, June 28, 2008, at her daughter's home in Moses Lake, WA.

Pauline Stoering was born July 24, 1916, in Woodworth, ND, the daughter of William and Ranka (Myrdal) Stoering. She graduated from high school in Woodworth and from Nursing School at Trinity Hospital in Jamestown, ND. She married John James Edward Cobean on August 5, 1940. She worked as a RN at Jamestown Hospital, was the first Director of Nursing Personnel at Central Dakota Nursing Home and finished her career in nursing working for Dr. Bell in Jamestown. She also owned the Showcase Uniform and Gift Shop in Jamestown. After her retirement, she and her husband sold their farm north of Jamestown and moved to Hamilton, MT. They lived there until his death in 1985. The following year she moved to Seattle, WA, then last year to Moses Lake, WA. She was a member of the First Presbyterian Church and belonged to Eastern Star.

She is survived by three sons, John (Mary) in Apollo Beach, FL., Billy (June) in Camas, WA., and Bob (Joan) in Palm Desert, CA., and one daughter Sally (Kelvin) Korsmoe in Moses Lake, WA. She has 7 grandchildren, and 12 great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Edward, two

brothers, John and Harold, three sisters, Carolyn, Beatrice and Helen, and three grandchildren.
