Pete Thompson, 58, of Moses Lake passed away at Samaritan Hospital on March 7th of longstanding health issues. He was born in Alameda California on November 2, 1955 to Roy and Beverly Thompson. He graduated from Moses Lake High School in 1975 and was employed by the Moses Lake School District for 30 years as a groundskeeper until his retirement.
