5. Turn right to stay on Hay Lacrosse Rd.

Then 4.37 miles

6. Turn right onto Big Alkali Rd.

Then 0.22 miles

7. Welcome to HAY, WA.

1. If you reach John Henley Rd you've gone about 0.1 miles too far
