Robert Lewis Webb was born in Ephrata, WA on September 6, 1949, to Lewis James Webb and Rosie Julia Webb., he died surrounded by his family on October 21, 2023, in Moses Lake, Washington after his battle with cancer. He had a varied life serving in the Coast Guard during the Vietnam War. Followed by a career as an Ironworker in Seattle, WA where he was part of the construction crew building the King Dome and Columbia Tower and then a nursing career at Western State Hospital as a lead nurse and counselor. He married Mary Elizabeth Welsh on August 28, 1971, and they recently celebrated 52 years of marriage. Together they became foster parents in 2005, fostering many children that continue to call them grandpa and grandma. Robert enjoyed construction, welding and had many projects up to his last days.

In his final years he spent time seeking to know his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, by daily reading the Bible, attending Sunday service and Wednesday Bible studies. This and spending time with his family brought him happiness in the last few years of his life.

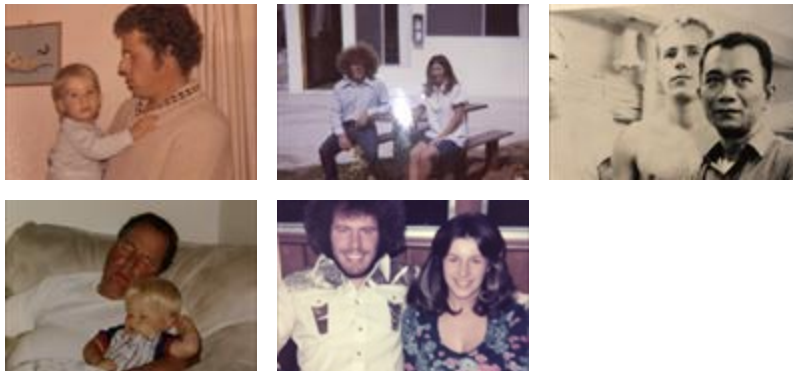

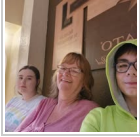
