



## Robert E. Shearer

November 21, 1922 - May 16, 2008

Robert E. Shearer, 85, longtime Moses Lake resident, passed away Friday, May 16, 2008 at his home. Memorial services will be held 10:00 A.M., Wednesday, May 21, 2008 at Kayser's Chapel of Memories. Arrangements are in care of Kayser's Chapel and Crematory.

Robert was born November 21, 1922 in Payette Idaho, son of the late Alfred and Grace (Edwards) Shearer. He was raised in Caldwell, Idaho where he was also educated. Following his schooling he farmed in the Caldwell area until enlisting in the U. S. Navy in 1945. He served aboard the USS Oracle Mine Sweeper in the Pacific Theater of World War II until his honorable discharge in 1946. He was awarded the Asiatic-Pacific American Area Victory Medal for his service. He returned to Caldwell and farming following the war. In 1953 he, along with good friend, Jack Saulls, moved with their families to Moses Lake. Robert settled in the Mae Valley area where he farmed for many years. He then worked for the U & I Sugar Company as a warehouse foreman until the plant closed around 1980. In the early 1980's he worked at International Titanium, Inc. until his retirement.

Robert enjoyed hunting and fishing and loved to garden, growing tomatoes and corn for all in the neighborhood.

He was a lifelong member of the V.F.W., and a member of both the American Legion and Eagles Lodge.

He is survived by his children, Paul Ernest and Brigid Johnson, California, Tom Shearer, Nampa, Idaho, Ray and Laurie Shearer, Moses Lake, N.K. and

Benita Shearer, Moses Lake, A. J. and Rhonda Shearer, Savannah, Georgia; two sisters, Gracie Tietsort, Nampa, Idaho and Barbara Thiel, Ontario, Oregon; numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by several brothers and sisters.
