



Roland "Ron" O. Gendron

Roland "Ron" O. Gendron, 73, a resident of Moses Lake and formerly of Vermont passed away Friday, February 17, 2012 at Coloumbia Crest Care and Rehab, his loving wife at his side.

He was born in Granville, Vermont, son of the late Real and Alice (Westover) Gendron. He served his apprenticeship as a sheet metal worker when he was 18 and 19 years old, then becoming a journeyman. Ron was married to Mary M. Levitt. He served in the United State Air Force and was honorably discharged.
